The following steps are designed to create an objective and clear process for families who are requesting financial aid for their student(s). Please note financial aid funds are limited by application deadlines and other factors, so the earlier you apply, the better!

STEP 1

Complete the required Grant & Aid

Cost: \$40.00

STEP 2

Review the Financial Aid opportunities (see back) so that you are familiar with what you may qualify for this school year.

STEP 3

ECA Administration team will review your FACTS financial assessment and create a Tuition Agreement based on the analysis.

STEP 4 OPTION A

Approve your Tuition Agreement -Upon review of the proposed agreement sent to you by ECA Administration, sign & return it. This completes the Financial Aid process.

STEP 4 OPTION B Request a Review of your Tuition Agreement If upon review of your initial proposed agreement you wish to request additional or different financial aid opportunities, do not sign the agreement. Contact us to request a review and provide any pertinent information that may help us with this process.

ALL Tuition Agreements must be completed & signed before the first day of school.

EVERY CHILD DESERVES TO KNOW CHRIST (ECDC)

The Oregon Conference of Seventh-day Adventists offers this grant for all eligible students in Kindergarten and 1st grade. Funding is limited and is based on the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment. It requires the partnership of family churches. Returning families who previously received this grant must re-apply before June 15 in order to be eligible for maximum award percentage.

CHURCH SCHOLARSHIP

Every year, our constituent churches budget generously for student scholarship funds based on the financial needs of our families. Families are strongly encouraged to discuss their financial needs with their church pastor while applying for financial aid. This aid is available to both SDA and non-SDA families.

PARTNERING FOR ETERNITY (PFE)

This unique grant opportunity, which is newly supported by the SFFC Foundation, is a participation-based scholarship available to K-8 students. Approved students will learn about service, growth, and friendship through regular meetings with a mentor for the duration of the school year. Visits are followed by a written assignment which encourages students to reflect on their experience. Students who are approved for PFE are making a commitment for the entire school year.

NPUC HISPANIC STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

The North Pacific Union Conference of Seventh-day Adventists offers this scholarship for families of Hispanic/Latino origin. This scholarship is unique in that it requires financial backing from the family's church and ECA.

ECA WORTHY STUDENT

Each year, this fund is supported by several sources including generous donors & various fundraising events. Funds are distributed to families based on the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment analysis provided to the school.
